

# EXECUTIVE SUMMARY REPORT – REGULAR JUNE 2023

# **FINANCE**

- The average price of diesel fuel was \$1.3422 per litre compared to the budgeted price of \$2.50 per litre.
- The fuel burn rate of 61.2 L/100KM was up 2.0 L/100KM from last year.
- The long-term interest rate was renewed at 6.25%. Last June the rate was 3.17%.
- Ridership in June was the second highest month on record (behind last month). Total ridership of 400,379 was up 31% from the same month in 2022 (305,173), up 111% from 2021 (190,113), up 59% from 2019 (252,025), and 39% above budget (286,620). Last June's total of 305,173 was the previous highest June ever.
- This month, the farebox (GFI) system recorded \$93,225 in coin. The actual processed coin was \$94,088 which is a 0.9% variance. This does not include \$7,307 in bills received on buses during the month.

- Close to 100% of waitlisted trips during weekdays/evenings are being accommodated.
  Weekends remain a challenge, but TOK is scheduling every available driver (including overtime shifts) and maximizing all taxi resources available to them. Customers whose trips cannot be accommodated are being notified by 3pm the day before.
- New, compatible seatbelt extenders for the buses are being supplied by the manufacturer to try to resolve the issue of problematic shoulder belts. The ratcheting action of the locking mechanism causes very restricted movement for passengers, making it very uncomfortable.
- Driver recruitment is continuing.
