











## Public Transit & Alert Level 2 What you need to know:

**EFFECTIVE AUGUST 24, 2020**

-  The number of passengers on board the bus at any time is limited to the **seated capacity**. Standing loads are not permitted.
-  The first seat on the bus is not available to riders.
-  **The wearing of masks is MANDATORY for passengers** unless exempt for medical reasons.
-  For visibility and safety reasons, Transit Operators are only required to wear masks when outside of the driver's compartment.
-  If possible, practice **physical distancing** of 6 feet (2 arm lengths) from driver and other passengers.
-  When using **transfers**, please show it to the driver and dispose of it in the garbage can provided.
-  If paying cash fares, please provide **exact fare in coin** as buses are not equipped to accept paper currency.
-  **Exit** bus through the rear door.
-  **Round trips** are not permitted (a trip that starts & ends at the same stop).
-  If **sick**, do not use public transit.

### Protect yourself and others while using public transit

- Cover your cough and sneeze with a tissue or into your arm, not your hand; and
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Wash your hands frequently or use hand sanitizer.
