Growth Plan: Development of a growth plan (scheduled for Fall 2023) will be delayed. Information from the upcoming customer survey will be key to establishing anticipated growth rates and other details required for future planning and decision-making. The General Manager will provide further details on known priority areas for service improvement based on recent ridership trends.
