We're replacing all of our bus stops and the new ones are jam-packed with useful information for customers including:

- + NEXT BUS DEPARTURE INFORMATION*
- + ROUTES SERVICING THE BUS STOP*
- + ACCESSIBLE SERVICE INFORMATION

It's amazing how much information can be stored on those little signs...

Bus STOP ID - use this 4-digit number to find out which routes service the stop and get next bus departure times from this stop. Use your text-enabled device or visit metrobus.com/nextbus

This area of the sign is used to designate accessible transit service. See descriptions on reverse

Text 'routes' to **88188** to get information about the routes servicing the stop and the next departure times for those routes

Text any 4-digit STOP ID to 88188 and get the next scheduled departure times for routes servicing that stop.

Begin by texting 'routes' to 88188

Wait for a response and reply with the 4-digit stop id

You will receive a list of routes servicing the stop





Reply with a valid route number from the list provided**

Response will be next scheduled departures from the stop for the route you selected

** If only one route services a bus stop, the reply will be the next scheduled departures from the stop - you will not be prompted to reply with a route number.

ACCESSIBLE SERVICE DESIGNATIONS

Along our accessible low floor (ALF) transit routes, bus stops are designated as fully accessible, not accessible or non-standard. For an upto-date list of of which of our routes is accessible, pick up a current copy of our Accessible Transit Service Handbook or visit metrobus.com/ALF.





Bus stop is fully accessible: Standard ALF Bus Stop

The blue mobility decal on the bus stop indicates the bus stop meets Metrobus' accessible standards - the ramp can be deployed, the bus stop has a concrete landing pad that meets our accessibility standards with access to a sidewalk, and accessible low floor buses are used to serve designated accessible routes at this stop.

Bus stop is not accessible
The blue mobility decal with a red line
through it indicates the bus stop is not
accessible and the driver cannot deploy
the boarding ramp at this location.

Non-standard ALF Bus Stop
This bus stop does not display an
accessibility decal. The boarding ramp
can be deployed, but these stops are
not considered accessible by Metrobus
standards and may only be used at the
individual's own determination and risk.
